- 1. Paint 1 thick coat of Star Dust all over the outside of the mug until no white is showing.
- 2. When the color has lost its shine, take a slightly damp sponge and gently wipe the Star Dust off the mug. You want to wipe lightly, removing the color from just the raised parts of the texture. This will leave the color in just the cracks, giving it an antiqued look. For best results, continually rinse your sponge in your water bowl while you wipe, as needed, and squeeze out the water well so it doesn't drip onto your pottery.
- 3. Paint 3 thick coats of Dusty Sage over the outside of the mug, top rim, and handle.
- 4. Paint 3 thick coats of Marshmallow Creme on the inside of the mug.
- 5. Stilt and fire to Cone 06. Do not clear glaze.

- 2. When the color has lost its shine, take a slightly damp sponge and gently wipe the Olive-You off the bowl. You want to wipe lightly, removing the color from just the raised parts of the texture. This will leave the color in just the cracks, giving it an antiqued look. For best results, continually rinse your sponge in your water bowl while you wipe, as needed, and squeeze out the water well so it doesn't drip onto your pottery.
- 3. Paint 3 thick coats of Dusty Sage over the outside of the bowl and top rim.
- 4. Paint 3 thick coats of Marshmallow Creme on the inside of the bowl.
- 5. Stilt and fire to Cone 06. Do not clear glaze.

#### Instructions:

- 1. Paint 3 thick coats of Dusty Sage on the bottom of the plate. Let dry.
- 2. Place the leaf patter underneath the clear contact paper and trace it onto the paper backing.
- 3. Cut out the leaves and stick them to the top of the plate.
- 4. Paint 3 thick coats of Dusty Sage on the top and edges of the plate.
- 5. When the Dusty Sage has lost its shine, peel off the contact paper.
- 6. Paint 3 coats of Olive-You on the leaves and make a stem to connect them.
- 7. With the handle of the pouncer, accent the edges with large dots of Banana Boat.
- 8. With the new eraser of a pencil, make smaller clusters of dots with the Star Dust.
- 9. Stilt and fire to Cone 06. Do not clear glaze.
