Wavy Ice Cream Dish DB28571

Potter's sponge
Container for water

Foil or foam plate for palette

Pencil
Contact paper
Scissors
Paper towel
#6 Fan Brush
#6 Found Brush
#1 Liner Brush
White and Red French
Dimensions or Writer Bottles

CMM Colors: • 47 Deep Sea • 98 Red Head • 67 Snow Flake

TIPS

• To use writer bottles, remove lid and tip. Using a skewer or thin stick, stir the paint well. If needed, add a tiny amount of water and stir well. Replace tip and test on paper for desired flow.

THEME Fourth of July TAGS Fourth of July, Independence Day, fireworks, ice cream, red white and blue



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire piece to remove dust and contaminants.

2. Lightly sketch star on contact paper. Cut out, remove backing to create stencil and apply to cup.

3. Using Fan Glaze brush, paint 3 coats Deep Sea to cup allowing color to fade nearing the stencil to create a glow around star. Brush bottom as well. Let dry between each coat. Remove stencil.

4. Pour some Red Head into bottle with writer tip (or use Red French Dimensions). Use to make a star or dot inside the white star.

5. Make bursts and dots around star with Red Head to replicate fireworks. Let dry.

6. Pour some Snow Flake into bottle with writer tip (or use White French Dimensions). Use to make bursts and dots adding to the fireworks. Let dry.

7. Brush two coats of clear glaze to inside cup and to the fireworks. Let dry.

8. Stilt on kiln shelf and fire to cone 06.
